

ANNOUNCEMENT

WHAT: The Education for Development Scholarship Program (EDSP)

DEADLINE: November 10 or Until Slots are Filled

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The applicant must be:

1. An OWWA active member direct dependent. Beneficiary is limited to children of married/unmarried OFWs, and/or brother/ sister of unmarried OFWs;
2. A grade 12 senior high school student at the time of application or a high school graduate/ out of school youth who does not have yet earned units in college;

3. Must be a 21 years of age or younger;
4. With a general weighted average (GWA) or higher than 85% from the two consecutive preceding school years;
5. For those who are already enrolled in 2nd to 5th year in College:
 - Single; Not more than 30 years Old;
 - With a grade of not lower than letter B or 85 in all academic & non-academic subjects from the previous school years
6. A Filipino citizen.

SCHOLARSHIP PRIVILEGES:

- a) The scholar is entitled to a financial assistance of P30, 000.00 per semester to be paid directly to school. If the tuition fee is more than the financial assistance, the scholar should shoulder the difference; if less, the difference shall be released to the scholar upon the submission of the grades for the semester;

The scholar is free to choose his/her desired field of the study as long as the program is offered by a CHED accredited college/university.

DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS:

1. Accomplished Application Form (2 sets);
2. 2" x 2" Id picture (4 copies);

3. Proof of relationship to member:
 - a. Copy of Birth Certificate of the applicant, if the applicant is son/daughter of the OFW;
 - b. Copy of Birth Certificate of the applicant & OFWs CENOMAR, if related as brother/ sister;
 - NSO or LCR Copy
4. Form 137 in Grade 11 & Junior High;
5. Proof of OWWA contribution (any of the following):
 - a. Official Receipt of OWWA Contribution;
 - b. Certificate of Welfare Coverage;
 - c. OFW Information Sheet.

Note: Could be provided by OWWA.

6. Health Certificate;
7. School Principal Certification that the student belongs to the upper 20% of the graduating Class;
8. Good Moral Certificate.

WHERE TO SECURE APPLICATION FORMS:

1. OWWA Regional Welfare Office Caraga;
2. School Principal or Guidance Counselor;
3. PESO Manager in every LGU's (Municipality and Province);
4. OFW Family Circles/ Organizations (OFCs).
