We are happy to present the stellar performance of CSU through this 2018 annual report.

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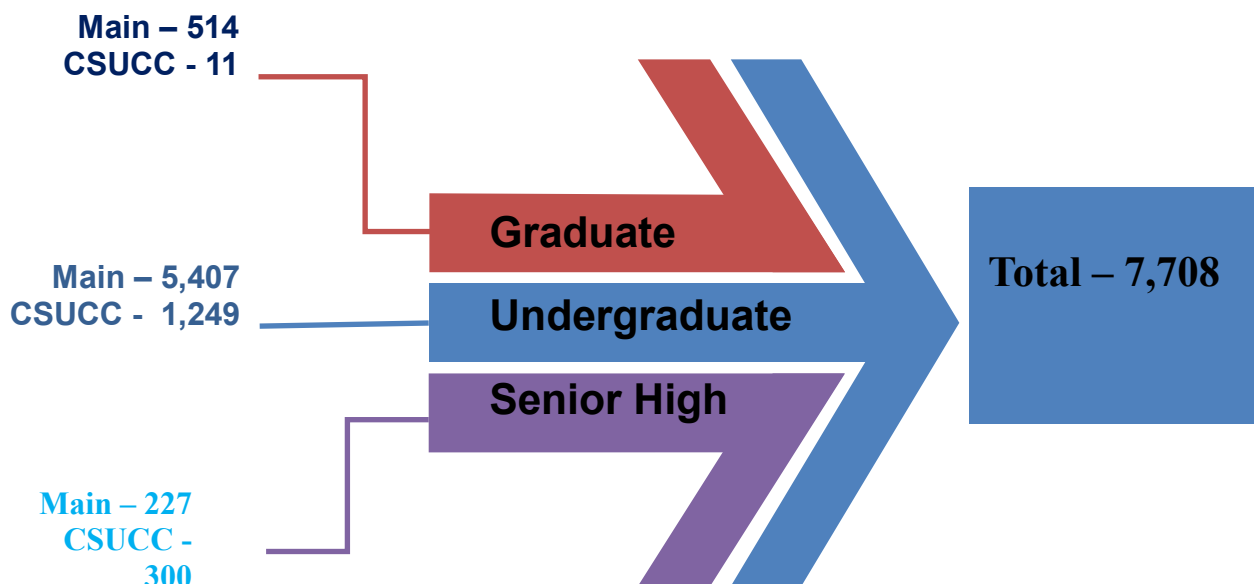

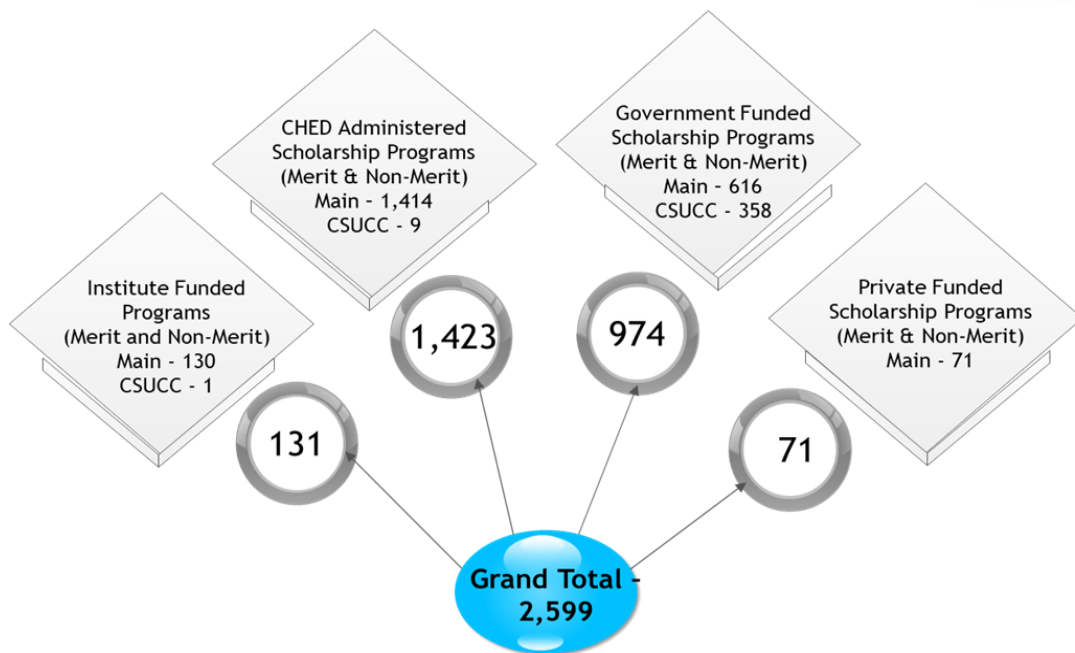

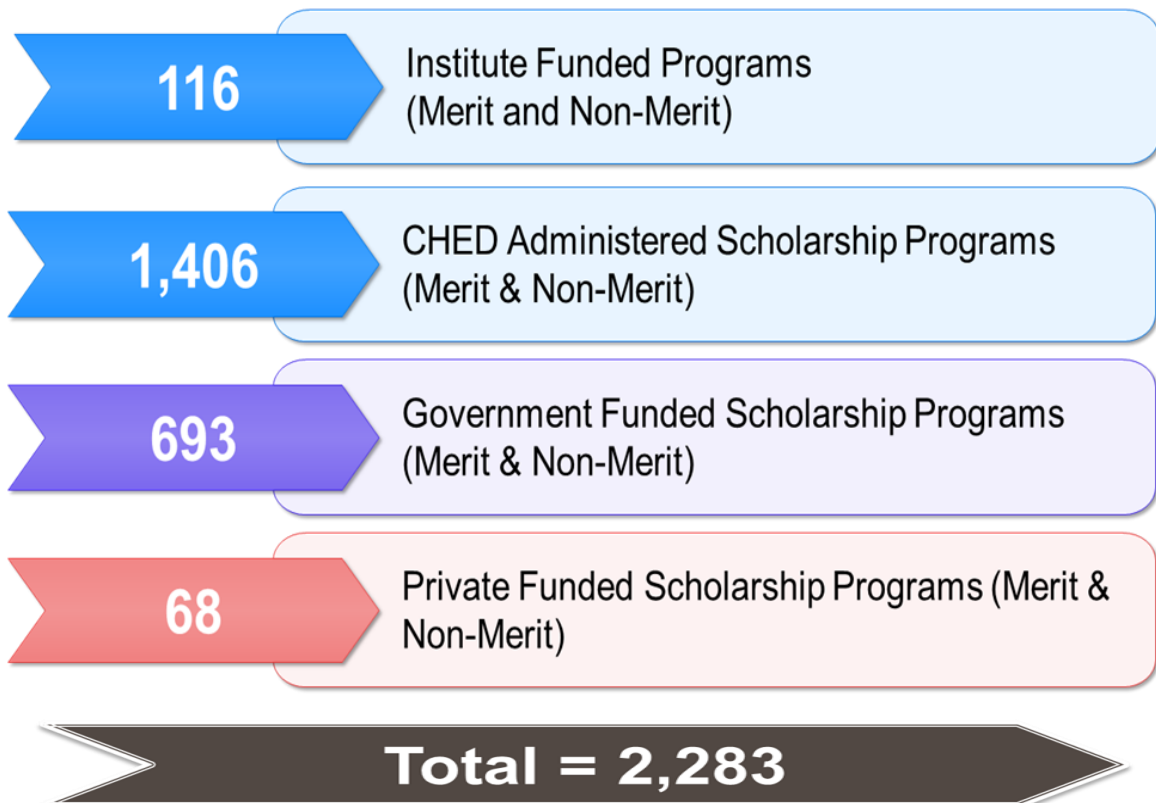
Enrollment, 1st Semester AY 2018-2019



Student Scholarship Grants, 2nd Semester AY 2017-2018

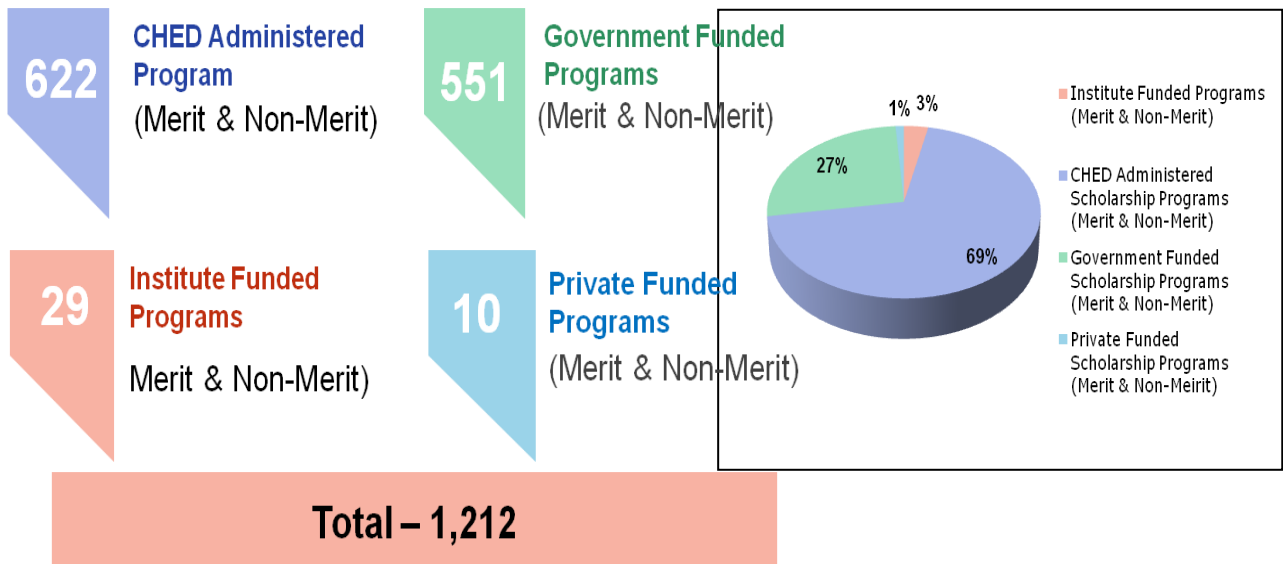


Student Scholarship Grants as of May 31, 2018



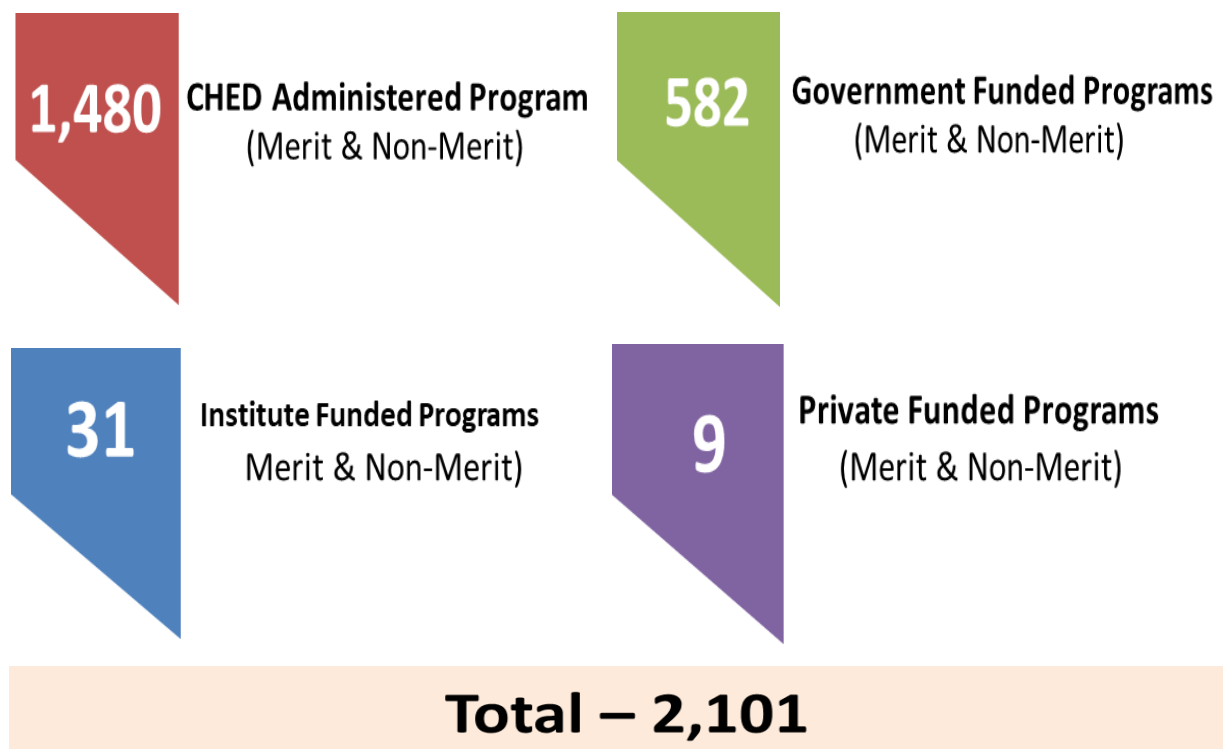

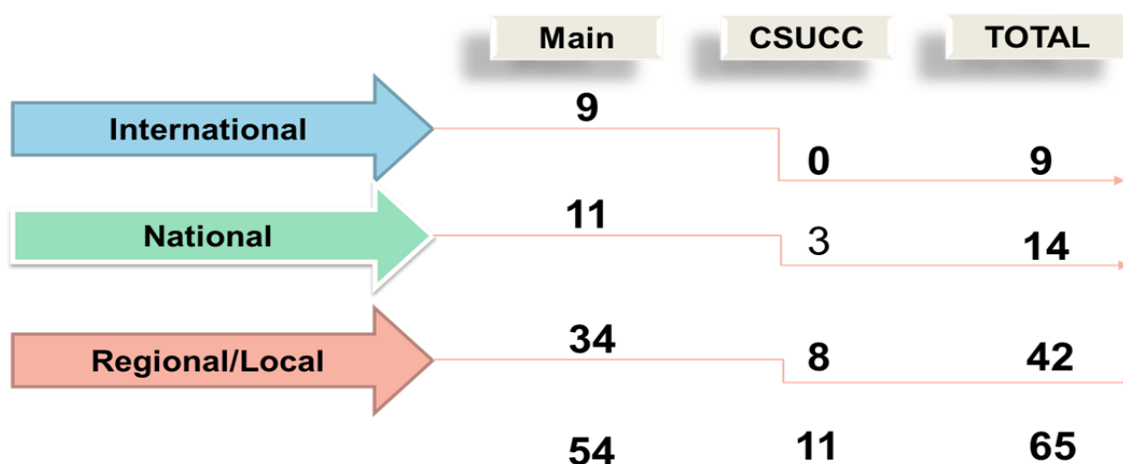

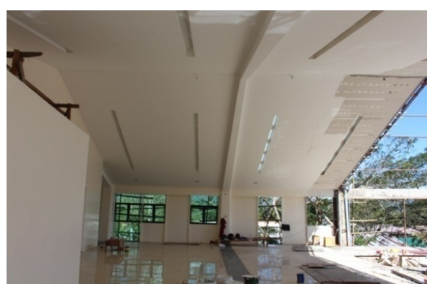
