CONTRACT FOR SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF SEMI-EXPENDABLE FURNITURE & FIXTURES EXPENSES (SEMI-EXPENDABLE FURNITURE & FIXTURES FOR THE OPERATION OF CSU CAMPUS AND CSUCC OFFICES AND COLLEGES)

This CONTRACT executed on the ____ day of 22 JUN 2023 by and between:

Caraga State University, a government agency of the Republic of the Philippines, hereinafter called "the Entity";

-and-

SLRUIZ CORPORATION a company duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office at Brgy. 95 Caibaan, Maharlika Highway, Tacloban City, Leyte, hereinafter called "the Supplier/Contractor/Consultant".

WHEREAS, the Entity invited Bids for certain goods and services/works/consulting services, particularly the procurement of semi-expendable furniture and fixtures to be utilized by different departments and academic units to improve functionality, organization, and overall efficiency of university spaces, enhancing both administrative and academic operations;

WHEREAS, the Supplier/Contractor/Consultant submitted a responsive bid and was awarded the contract for the procurement item no 1 & 2 in the total amount of **Two Million Three Hundred Thirteen Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (P2,313,200.00)**, hereinafter referred to as the "Contract Price."

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. Unless otherwise stated, terms and expressions used in this Contract shall have the same meanings as those assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract, which form an integral part of this Contract.
2. The following documents as required by the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 12009 shall form part and be read and construed as integral parts of this Contract, viz.:
 - a. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBD);
 - *For Procurement of Goods*
 - i. Invitation to Bid;
 - ii. Instruction to Bidders;
 - iii. Bid Form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder's bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g., Bidder's response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;

- iv. Bid Data Sheet;
 - v. Schedule of Requirements;
 - vi. Technical Specifications;
 - vii. General and Special Conditions of Contract;
 - viii. Supplemental Bid Bulletins, if any; and
 - ix. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Entity.
 - b. Winning bidder's bid, including the Eligibility Requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted;
 - c. Performance Security;
 - d. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder's Conforme thereto; and
 - e. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBD, such as but not limited to the Notice to Proceed and Warranty Security.
3. In consideration of the total Contract Price for item no. 1 & 2 of **Two Million Three Hundred Thirteen Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (P2,313,200.00)**, or such other sums as may be determined in accordance with the terms of the Contract, the Supplier/Contractor/Consultant agrees to deliver and perform the items and related services for the **Supply and Delivery of Semi-Expendable Furniture & Fixtures Expenses (Semi-Expendable Furniture & Fixtures for the Operation of CSU Campus and CSUCC Offices and Colleges)** described herein in accordance with the terms and conditions specified in the Contract and its annexed documents.
4. The **Caraga State University** agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum to the Supplier/Contractor/Consultant in accordance with the schedule and manner provided in the Bidding Documents and its annexes.
5. Any dispute, difference, or claim arising out of or relating to this Contract, including its existence, validity, interpretation, breach, or termination thereof, may be submitted to arbitration or other form of alternative dispute resolution in accordance with the applicable law, such as Republic Act No. 9285 (Alternative Dispute Resolution Act of 2004) or Executive Order No 1008, series 1985 (Construction Industry Arbitration Law).
